


A special meeting of the Baxter City Council was called to order on Monday, April 18, 2022 at 6:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of City Hall by Mayor Bryan DeJong. Council members present were Josh Lokenvitz, Josh Meckley, Tootie Samson, and Dan Kunkel by Zoom electronic meeting. Jason Robinson was absent. Police Officer Mason Highland was also in attendance.

Samson moved to approve the Agenda. Meckley seconded. Motion carried, all ayes.

Discussion Police Chief Position – Mayor DeJong informed Council members that the second interested candidate for the position had withdrawn his application leaving one candidate at this time. After lengthy discussion, the Council agreed to proceed with the final candidate accordingly.
